Evaluation Models

- An evaluation model is useful for explaining the process on which variables, items, or events are evaluated
- Provides a systematic plan or framework for evaluation

Evaluation Models (cont.)

- Accreditation Model: Evidence-Based Evaluation
 - Ongoing self-evaluation surrounding the achievement of outcomes to support quality improvement of nursing programs
 - Provides process to determine the extent to which a program achieves its mission, goals, and outcomes
